On-Line Access Contract for Student Usage

All Eastford Public School computers are to be used in a responsible, efficient, ethical and legal manner. Computers are used to support learning and to enhance instruction. The Internet, a network of networks, allows people to interact with hundreds of thousands of network and other computers.

Internet access is provided for students to conduct research and communicate with others in relation to school work. Access to network services is given to students who agree to act in a considerate and responsible manner. Parent permission is required. Access is a privilege, not a right. Therefore, based upon the acceptable use guidelines outlined in this document, the system administrators (technology teacher, library media specialist and principal) will deem what is inappropriate use. The system administrators may deny, revoke, or suspend specific user access at any time.

I agree to take personal responsibility for following the rules of the acceptable use policy stated in this contract.

I will:

- Use the on-line resources provided by my school ONLY for school-sanctioned projects.
- Use the on-line resources provide by my school ONLY with the permission of a staff member.
- Use on-line language which is consistent with school policy. I will not swear, use vulgarities, or any other inappropriate language.
- Not tamper with equipment or software
- Not alter the network interface
- Not attempt to access to the data and files of others
- Not attempt to access information on the Internet, or other on-line services, that are not consistent with the educational goals of the school
- Will follow copyright laws.
- Report and problems or breaches of this agreement to a teacher.
- Not use the Internet inappropriately and understand that if I do, my behavior will result in :
 - Suspension of on-line privileges within the school building
 - Being subjected to disciplinary measures under Board of Education policy, and/or being referred to the appropriate legal authorities, if warranted.
