Professional training, which includes advanced graduate study relevant to the teaching assignment, and which increases his/her understanding of gifted and talented pupils

and successful classroom teaching experience.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should possess a high degree of self-understanding and

security; a warmness toward and acceptance of these pupils; a willingness to seek further training, if needed and recommended; a willingness to meet regularly with other staff members and parents;

and an ability to get along with people.

REPORTS TO: Principal

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Takes responsibility for the development of programs and/or, activities for identified gifted students selected to participate in the program.
- 2. Assists the administration in assessing needs for additional resources, including instructional, curriculum, student evaluation, equipment, etc.
- 3. Provides specific recommendations for program and/or intervention methods for: individual students.
- 4. Acts as interpreter of individual needs of each student to parents, teachers and administrators on an ongoing basis.
- 5. Confers with parents during regularly scheduled report card conference periods.
- 6. Keeps ongoing students' records necessary for program maintenance.
- 7. Order sthe appropriate materials and equipment necessary for the program.
- 8. Co-teaches and models instructional techniques in the classrooms
- 9. Performs such additional duties as may be delegated by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.
