Extra Class Activities

The school district shall provide, within budgetary limitations, student opportunities for participation in extra class activities including athletics, clubs, music and drama, and other student activities and programs.

Participation in such programs and activities is a privilege and not a right. The School District Administrators may restrict any student whose behavior is unacceptable during these programs and/or activities from participation in any or all extra class activities for up to a maximum of one school year. If student(s) is/are restricted, to ensure student constitutional rights and due process protections, a designated school administrator shall conduct a hearing to allow students to contest charges, which can lead to suspension of student activity privileges. These hearings shall be in accordance with Eastford Suspension/Expulsion/Exclusion/Removal Policy #5116 and the Student Grievance Procedure Policy #5153.

The Eastford Board of Education encourages a positive working relationship with all parents, including those who home-school their children, are enrolled in alternative educational programs such as private and/or parochial schools, and, those whose children attend local public schools which do not offer these activities. Parents of children who are enrolled in such programs may request that their child(ren) participate in extra curricular activities in accordance with all Board of Education regulations. Such participation, *if granted*, shall not have the effect of excluding Eastford Elementary School students from participation.

Extra Class Activities

Participation in Extra Class Activities

Parents of children who are home-schooled and/or are enrolled in an alternative educational program, may request participation of their children in extra class activities or intramural activities subject to the regulations outlined below:

- Proof of immunizations
- Proof of health insurance
- Satisfactory Behavior
- If in an alternative education program, evidence provided by the principal of current enrollment and satisfactory academic standing.
- If home schooled, certification by the instructor of record of continued enrollment of the student at the appropriate grade level and satisfactory academic standing.
- Satisfactory Attendance

Provided that participation conforms with all pertinent regulations, permission shall not unreasonably be withheld so long as such participation does not exclude from the activity a student who is enrolled in the Eastford Elementary School.

Parents agree to provide transportation to and from the activity.
