Standard Precautions

As part of maintaining a healthy environment for staff and children, the following precautions will be followed by the Readiness Program and Maintenance Staff. All cleaning and sanitizing products must conform to the Green Clean Program* and are to be labeled with Manufacturer's Label. The Manufacturer's Safety Data (MSD) will be readily available for reference.

- All surfaces that are exposed to infectious bodily fluids must be made of a disposable material or one that can be sanitized.
- Staff will use disposable gloves when handling situations that expose them to bodily fluids, openings in the skin, and mucus membranes.
- When spills occur, staff members clean them up immediately with detergent followed by rinsing with water.
- After cleaning, staff members sanitize nonporous surfaces as described in the cleaning procedure.
- Staff clean carpet by blotting and spot cleaning with a sanitizing detergent and inform custodial staff of the need to shampoo carpet.
- Staff members dispose of contaminated materials in a plastic bag that is tied securely and placed in a secured container.
- Staff will use proper hand hygiene following all above situations. (refer to hand-washing chart)
